31. You send forth your Spirit, and they are cre - a - ted; and so you re - new the face of the earth.


32. May the glory of the Lord en - dure for ev - er; may the Lord rejoice in all his works.


33. He looks at the earth and it trem - bles; he touches the moun - tains and they smoke.




34. I will sing to the Lord as long as I live; I will praise my God while I have my being.
