25. O Lord, how manifold are your works! in wisdom you have made them all; the earth is full of your crea-tures.


26. Yonder is the great and wide sea with its living things too ma-ny to num-ber, crea-tures both small and great.

27. There move the ships, and there is that Lev - i - ath - an, which you have made for the sport of it.


28. All of them look to you to give them their food in due seas - on.

**\*Refrain**


30. You hide your face, and they are ter - ri - fied; you take away their breath, and they die and re turn to their dust.



31. You send forth your Spirit, and they are cre - a - ted; and so you re - new the face of the earth.




32. May the glory of the Lord en - dure for ev - er; may the Lord rejoice in all his works.
