1. The Lord is King; let the earth re - jice; let the multitude of the isles be glad.

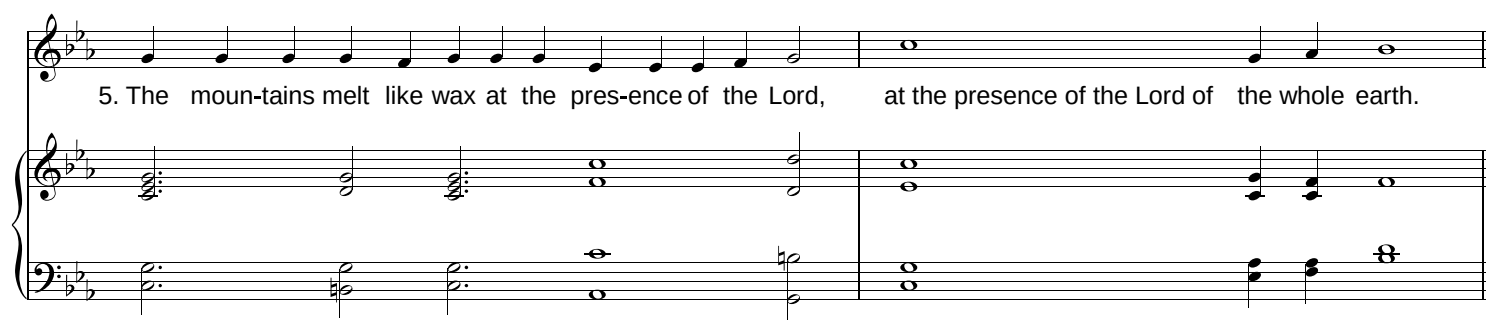
2. Clouds and dark-ness are round a - bout him, righteousness and justice are the foundations of his throne.

4. His light - nings light up the world; the earth sees it and is af - raid.

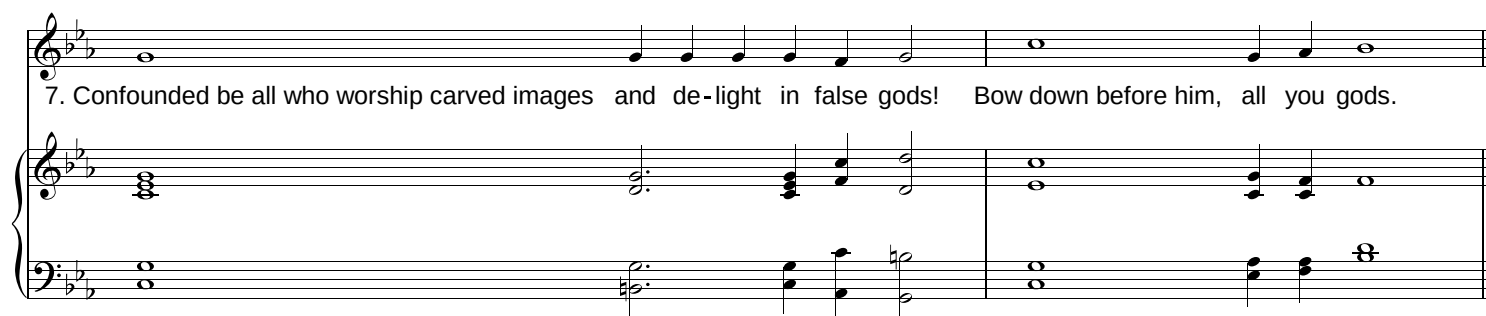
5. The moun-tains melt like wax at the pres-ence of the Lord, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.

6. The hea - vens de - clare his right-eous-ness, and all the peoples see his glo - ry.



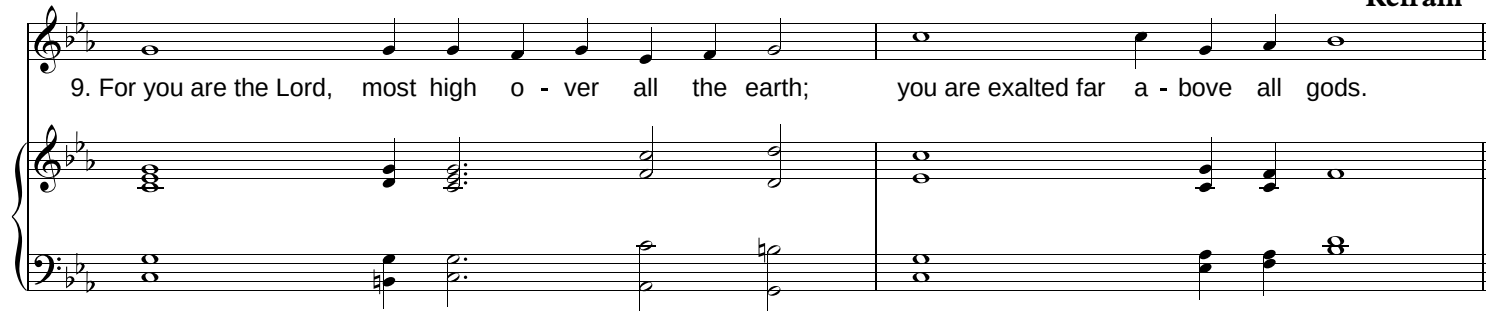
7. Confounded be all who worship carved images and de-light in false gods! Bow down before him, all you gods.



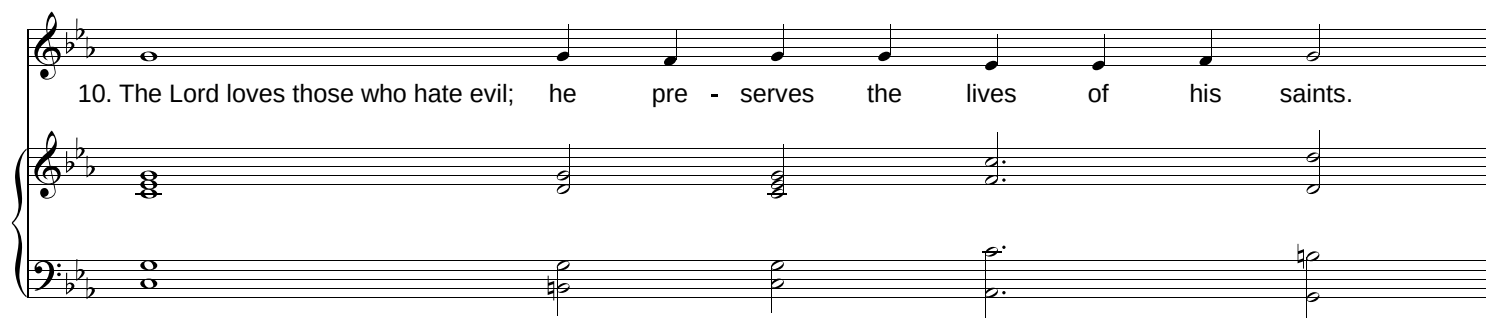
8. Zion hears and is glad, and the ci - ties of Ju - dah re-joice, because of your judg-ments, O Lord.

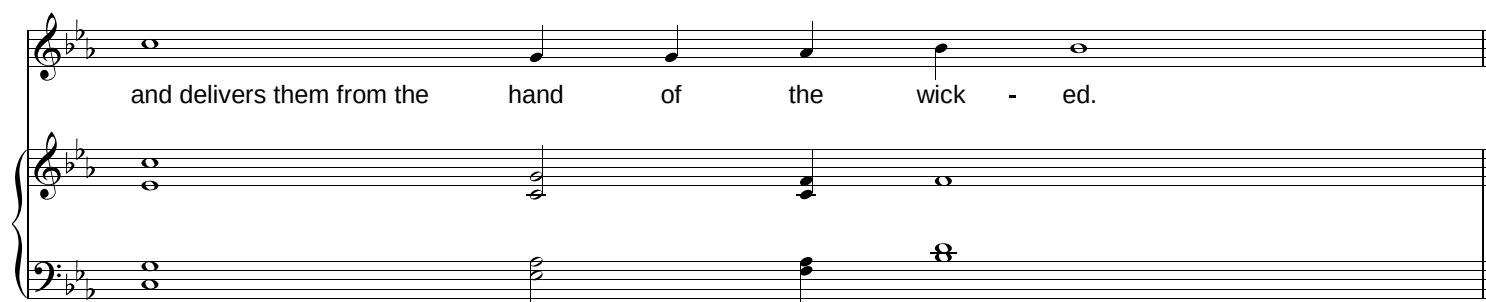
9. For you are the Lord, most high o - ver all the earth; you are exalted far a - bove all gods.
